Misinformation Vs Disinformation From Wikipedia

- Misinformation is incorrect or misleading <u>information</u> unintentionally presented as fact.
- This is contrasted with <u>disinformation</u> in that disinformation is *deliberately* deceptive.
- Misinformation is different from <u>rumor</u>, which is speculative.
- Even if later retracted, misinformation can continue to influence actions and memory

These are just "dog whistle" trojan horse issues to get the base involved.

So, What Is It Really About?

- It's about taking control of the school board followed by control of the school curriculum
- It's about getting candidates elected to the board who can then run for higher offices
- It's about getting parents to remove kids from public schools to enroll them in private schools and defunding public schools with vouchers
- There are well funded national organizations that have the above as their stated goals.

More Background Information

- A loose network of conservative groups with ties to major Republican donors and party-aligned think tanks is quietly lending firepower to local activists engaged in <u>culture war fights in schools</u> across the country.
- While they are drawn by the anger of parents opposed to school policies on racial history or COVID-19 protocols like mask mandates, the groups are often run by political operatives and lawyers standing ready to amplify local disputes.

IASB-Illinois Association of School Boards What is a school board and what does it do?

From the IASB website

- ...to provide local citizen control over education at a point as close to the parent and child as possible
- Perhaps the most important job of a school board is to hire a superintendent
- (Board members must) know the difference between governance (which is its job) and management (which is the administration's job).
- The Illinois Constitution grants boards of education wide latitude in governing their school districts, subject to numerous state laws and regulations.

Where It All Started

- <u>Christopher Rufo</u>, a senior analyst at the Manhattan Institute, is widely credited with being the ideological picador behind Trump's executive order banning critical race theory and diversity training in all federal programs.
- ... last March (2020), Rufo stated that his goal was to "run a public persuasion campaign" that would conflate any number of topics and deposit them into a new bucket called critical race theory.
- "We have successfully frozen their brand—'critical race theory'—into the public conversation and are steadily driving up negative perceptions," he wrote. "We will eventually turn it toxic, as we put all of the various cultural insanities under that brand category" Christopher Rufo

- School districts have added diversity and equity training for years to foster a more tolerant environment and to better position marginalized people for success.
- Trump's presidential election in 2016 changed the dynamics around racial equity and tolerance in America.
- In September 2020, Trump <u>ordered an end to diversity and equity</u> <u>training for federal contractors</u>.
- That came after Christopher Rufo of the conservative Manhattan Institute <u>appeared repeatedly on Tucker Carlson's Fox News</u> talk show to equate equity and social justice with critical race theory.

Critical race theory turning school boards into GOP proving grounds

- Frustrations over how kids are taught about systemic racism have turned once-sleepy school board elections into hyperlocal skirmishes with the power to polarize how a new generation learns about U.S. history and grow the ranks of Republican politicians.
- But it's the local races outside the spotlight, in elections that attract just a few hundred voters — that may define what students learn in the classroom for years to come.
- While such elections are often (supposed to be) nonpartisan, the **Republican Party** sees a rich opportunity to build a pipeline of new political candidates.

- "The left has spent many years and vast funding to stack local school boards," the Leadership Institute's website claims. "America's children suffer the effects of this liberal domination every day." The group adds, "Patriotic Americans must take back the schools."

GOP Operative Says It Hurts White Kids When 'Kids of Color Feel They Belong'

- Mary Beeman, a Republican campaign manager for school board candidates in a Connecticut town, has sparked controversy by telling participants of a virtual education forum that "helping kids of color to feel they belong has a negative effect on white, Christian, or conservative kids."
- Mary Beeman put forth that bizarre argument during a virtual education forum where the right-wing boogeyman known as "**critical race theory**" was discussed, according to local news outlet WFSB. She later sought to clarify her statement, which she admitted was "poorly worded," and claimed it had been shown "out of context."
- In trying to mop up the mess, Beeman said she'd been referring to "students who may have staunch Judeo-Christian values, or simply are conservative thinkers," and are now being "bullied into submission by their teachers and fellow students with left-leaning ideologies."
- Bill Bloss, the Guilford school board chairman, made clear he wasn't buying Beeman's excuses for the racist remark, questioning <u>"exactly what context would that comment be positive in."</u>

- In the hands of right-wing activists—pushed by Fox News personality Tucker
 Carlson, former President Donald Trump, and other Republican officials, "critical
 race theory" as a term has lost all meaning. Instead, it has become an all-purpose
 label with which to smear teachers and liberal politicians as anti-white, Marxist, or
 America-haters—and to justify the whitewashing of U.S. history.

Family Research Council Raises Money for Right-Wing School Board Takeover Campaign

- Family Research Council (FRC) President Tony Perkins is raising money to promote right-wing takeovers of local school boards, which he claims is necessary to "protect the hearts and minds of the next generation from the left-wing agenda."
- Perkins, ignoring the national right-wing groups (already) heavily involved in the right-wing school board takeover effort, portrayed the campaign as a grassroots uprising
- FRC Action, Perkins said, is "focusing our national expertise on key local elections by providing, at no charge, much needed resources to help replace radical school board members with Christian and conservative parents and other qualified candidates."

- Washington Post October 1, 2021
- A template letter circulated by Independent Women's Forum offers a glimpse into a well resourced campaign against public health regulations
- It is motivated, the author explains, by a desire to "speak up for what is best for my kids." And it fervently conveys the author's feelings to school leaders: "I do not believe little kids should be forced to wear masks, and I urge you to adopt a policy that allows parental choice on this matter for the upcoming school year."
- But the heartfelt appeal is not the product of a grass roots groundswell. Rather, it is a template drafted and circulated this week within a conservative network built on the scaffolding of the Koch fortune and the largesse of other GOP megadonors.

DEMOLISHING PUBLIC LIBRARIES FROM THE INSIDE: NILES PUBLIC LIBRARY IS A WARNING

- Who sits on the board of your local library can mean the difference between a thriving library ecosystem or a community resource being pulled apart brick by brick.
- The latter is what's happening at Niles Public Library in Niles, Illinois, a community roughly 30 minutes from the heart of Chicago.
- The April 2021 election in Niles-Maine Township had low turnout. Turnout for the election was 8.4%, and numerous roles on the ballot were uncontested.
- But the election in April 2021 changed everything. Over the course of the next few months and the installation of a new Board of Directors, the library's funding has been deeply slashed, hours reduced to below-state-standard levels, the library director quit, and essential services to the community shuttered.
- Unfortunately, Niles-Maine Public Library isn't the only public library seeing this kind
 of destruction from the inside. They're running for small boards and destroying
 beloved public institutions from the inside in the name of white supremacy.

Could this Happen Here?

- "Y'all paying attention to Indiana and HB 1134?
- Educators won't be able to teach "divisive concepts" without permission from parents.
- Parents have to approve teacher lesson plans before the school year starts. Lessons plans for the entire school year are due by June 30th prior to school year beginning.
- Teachers cannot talk to students who are having any sort of mental health crisis, or personal issues without permission from the parents.
- There's a lot more highly concerning pieces to this bill but the TLDR version is that this is a bill that seeks to protect white supremacy and bury parts of history and science that don't fall in line with the white Christian extremist ideology.
- This extremist agenda goes beyond curriculum and seeks to completely dismantle our PUBLIC education system by forcing droves of teachers out of the profession which would cause religious based private schools to emerge as the only option for education.
- The entire public education system is under attack, and if you think it can't happen in Illinois you're wrong. We all must stand up and fight back.

If your voice isn't there, what voice fills the void?

- Contact School Board by email (Google/Bing search district and Board of Education, e.g. "D211 Board of Education"; Be short and professional
- Attend School Board meetings
- Sign up to speak or show support; Google the Board of Education to know the policies for Public Comments and where they fit into the agenda. Includes time limits and how to sign up to speak
- View Board meeting videos livestreamed or after the fact. Many district meetings are now live streamed and saved
- Recognize the groups showing up. Are they organized and with particular organizations. Network after meetings with like minded individuals and groups
- Join local progressive groups (school board specific or community); Indivisible, NWSOFA, Democrats. There are a lot of Facebook pages for these groups and also specifically for school district. I've seen a trend toward these FB groups being private
- Sign Witness Slips protecting schools and education Witness Slip Project (Illinois) https://www.facebook.com/groups/390967114607888
- Know your School Board members
- Find medical professionals, mental professionals and lawyers to be partners to speak at meetings. They are usually the people interviewed for newspaper articles

- Letters to the Editor. Great example: https://drive.google.com/file/d/1bTYiQV_82xIsCBVhymqtcx QWT3uabDxb/view?usp=sharing
- Create a group to attend Board meetings together; wear similar colors, masks to support; cheer; carry signs (#HonestyInEducation)
- Online petitions in favor of our issues or to provide support;
 Pro science petition has 2100+ signatures
- Find out about School Board curriculum policies. CRT is NOT taught in lower education. It's only taught in higher education
- Find out about your district's Equity or Wellness programs
- Run for office
- Find progressive people to run for office
- Sign up for webinars on the topic even if you can't make the event
- Find allies at Board meetings
- FOIA Requests
- Be a troll
- Share; Collaborate; Network (meeting notes, screen grabs)
- VOTE!

Messaging

- Be inclusive: "We should all want an honest and accurate education for our children" or "All children benefit from our equity program."
- Flip the script. Reclaim "freedom" and "choice". "We want freedom to pursue honest and accurate education".
- Say What You Are For
- Repeat, Repeat, Repeat

- Use Active Voice
- Don't Amplify the Opposition. Focus on equity, social justice and honest curriculum rather than CRT.
- It's all about the kids
- Liar, liar pants on fire. Call them out
- History and sex ed is taught based on age appropriate information.

<u>Paragraphs 2 & 3</u>: Explain in unemotional terms what the problem is.

<u>Paragraph 4</u>: Provide factual information that can be easily found with a simple Google search.

<u>Final Paragraph</u>: This should be a non-emotional, fact-based argument that anyone can check for being truthful.


